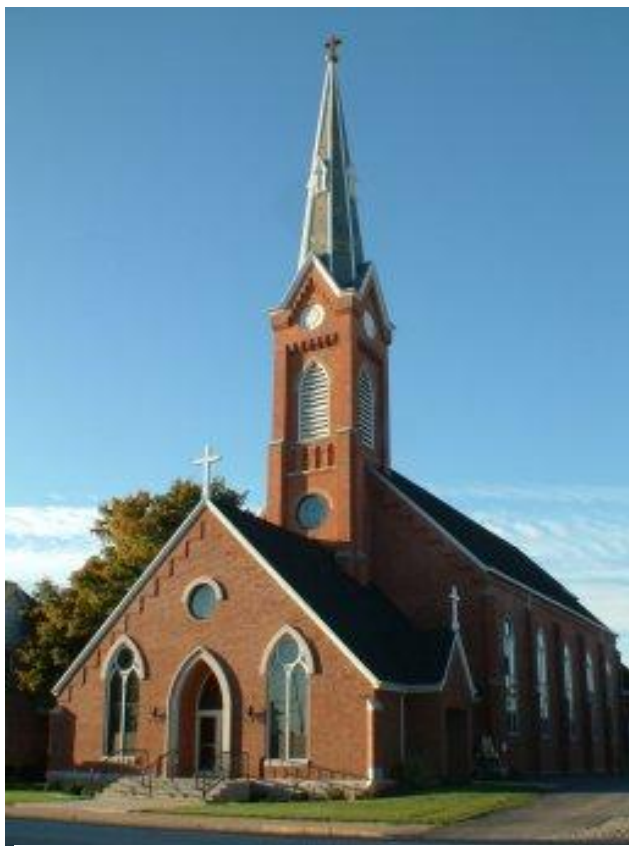

How to go to confession?

For many people, Lent is the time for celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation. For those who haven't been to this sacrament for months or years, here's a refresher:

- When you enter the reconciliation room, you may kneel before a screen, or walk around it to sit face-to-face with the priest.
- After the sign of the cross, you are invited to express your sins and place them before God for forgiveness and healing. This is best done in a conversational way, and the priest is part of the conversation.
- The priest then gives "penance" which may be a prayer or a good work that will help bring healing.
- You are invited to express sorrow for your sins – a traditional act of contrition or a prayer of sorrow in your own words.
- The priest says the prayer of absolution to which you respond "Amen."
- You are invited to give thanks to the Lord for his mercy.
