I would like to thank you for supporting our parish during this difficult time. Though some people are not able to make it to church they have been mailing or dropping off their offertory envelopes to church office. Your continual support has helped us to sail through these difficult times smoothly. Thank you again and God Bless your generosity.

Update on the fundraiser and roof project: As you know we have ongoing fund raiser for various projects at church. Our goal for this fund raiser is \$ 213,917.00. So far, we have raised \$ 71,094.25.

In the finance meeting held on February 02, 2021 we revisited the estimates for the roof. The prices of metal have increased by 12% since the time we had received last estimates in the fall of 2020. We determined that we are going to buy metal needed for roof and store it with the company warehouse so that the further price increases would not affect us.

I would like to once again appeal to all the members of the parish, if you have not donated toward this project, prayerfully consider donating to this project and help us meet the goal of fund raiser to complete the works needed for the proper upkeep of the buildings.
