Dear Brothers and Sisters,
“On one occasion, I heard these words: My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. This year's audit examined the audit period of July 1, 2018 through September 30, 2021. Bishop Daniel Thomas is pleased to announce that the Diocese was found to be in full compliance with the requirements in the *Charter* following the audit.
