Here I would like to present a quick update on the Living Christ Campaign.

**Parish Summary Disbursement Report - Data as of: 4/30/2023**

**TOTAL GOAL \$ 145,000.00**

Total pledges from start of campaign \$ 154,665.00

Total collections from start of campaign \$ 57,165.00

**Total cash due to parish from start of campaign \$ 20,007.75**

**(35% of collections up to goal, 50% thereafter, plus collections from lead gifts)**

**Disbursement of Parish Funds**

All parish disbursements from the *Living Christ* campaign are made directly to the Deposit and Loan Trust (D&L Trust). At the beginning of each wave of the campaign, a new account is established on behalf of every parish in that wave.

Funds will be disbursed to parish accounts on a 3 month-lag of when pledge payments were received from the donors. This means parishes will receive disbursements monthly from payments received 3 months prior. Thus, pledge payments received in March are being disbursed this month (June). This process will be in place for the continuation of the campaign and while pledges are being fulfilled.

**HVAC Project**

Our Parish Finance Council in its meeting held on February 15 has approved the estimates for the Air Conditioning of our Church. Presently the estimates are sent to the Diocese for approval. As soon as it's approved by the diocese, we will work on getting the job on scheduled. I am hoping that we will be able to get the project completed by mid-June. I will keep you informed about the progress of the project in the coming days.

While we are working on HVAC, we will also upgrade the much-needed electrical panels and some wiring as well.

The estimated cost of the HVAC project is \$55,000.00 and the electrical panel \$10,000.00. We are looking at the total of \$65000.00. Thank you for your support. God Bless!
