Dear Brothers and Sisters,  
When Jesus taught his disciples to pray, he taught them to pray for “thy Kingdom come...” In the gospel this weekend we hear Jesus speaking about the Kingdom of God through three different parables. These parables reveal to us the different aspects of God’s Kingdom.

Firstly, Kingdom of God is a Silent reality: Jesus speaks about God’s kingdom as a silent reality rather than a magnificent event – like a seed growing in the field.

Secondly, The Kingdom of God always has a humble beginning: Jesus also mentions about the beginning of the Kingdom is always exceedingly small and grows enormously big like a mustard seed.

Thirdly, the Kingdom of God works like a yeast in our lives: Just as yeast mixes with wheat flour and leavens the whole batch of wheat flour so also the Kingdom of God is invisibly present in our midst helping us to grow in our relationship with our God.
