Dear Brothers and Sisters,
Gospel this weekend is teaching us to consider the relationship between words and deeds. We must strive to translate our noble promises into noble performances, to carry out our fine words into fine deeds.

This gospel tells us that there are two common types of people in this world.

First, there are the people whose profession of words is much better than their practice. They thought that they are good because they followed all the laws. They will promise anything, make great protestations or solemn declaration of piety and fidelity. "I'm a catholic because I was baptized as a Catholic." But their practice lags behind.

Second, there are those whose practice is far better than their words. They claim to be tough, hard-headed materialists, not attending Sunday Masses but they are found to be doing kindly and generous things almost in secret as if they were ashamed of it. They profess to have no interest in the Church and in religion and yet when it comes to the bit, they live more Christian lives than many professing Christians. "Action speaks louder than words."

So, are we practicing what we profess? Are we consistent with what we said?
